However, according to the test results, the engine was judged to be suitable for model rocketry use and was approved by members of the ABRA Space Engine Testing Division.

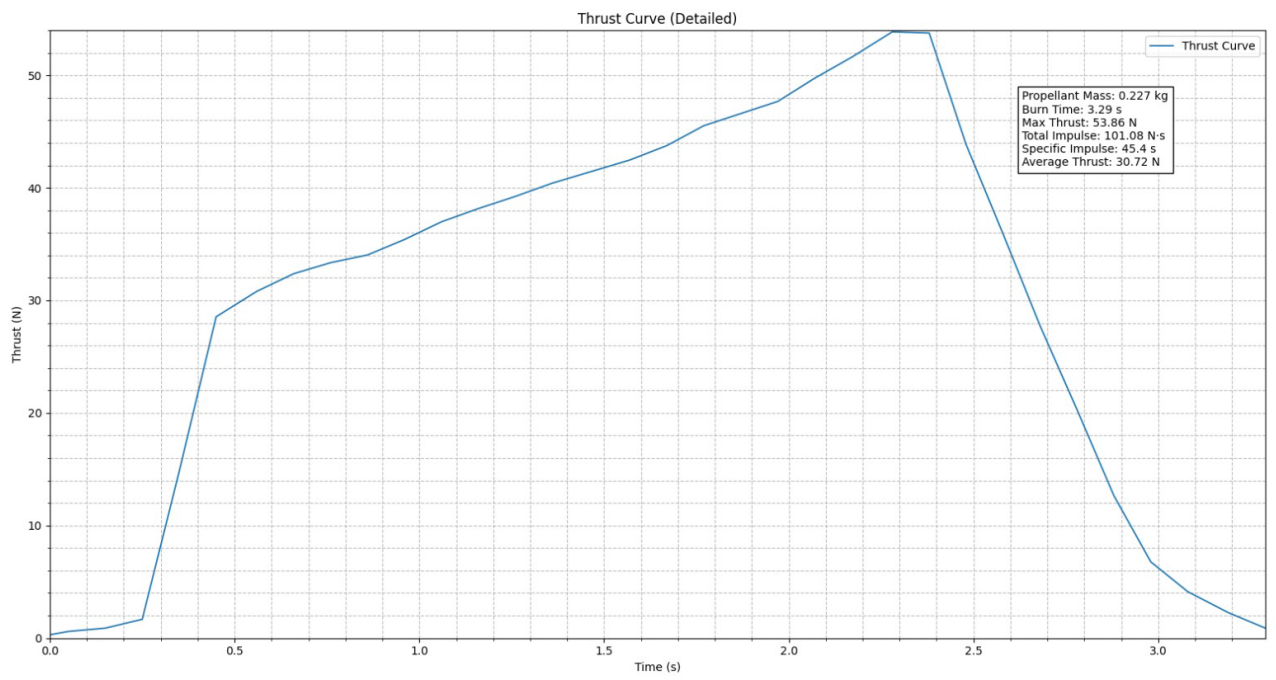
